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### **Message from the President**

On March 19th, 2020, the statewide stay-at-home order was issued. On March 21st, Inception's Program III, "Engaging the Orchestra" was scheduled to start. In 2019, we had offered private composition lessons on Zoom to complement live in-studio group mentoring sessions. Thus, we had no problem moving completely to the virtual platform immediately.

Virtual learning helped us grow exponentially, with students dialing in from Austin, Minneapolis, San Diego, and Goodyear, as well as L.A., and a mentoring pool now available from across the country and around the globe.

Where will we head in 2021? We will continue to scale with new partners and cohorts, come back live in some hybrid fashion, develop our VR app, and continue to foster the growth of our amazing young composers at the highest possible level.




# **COMPOSITION & MUSIC THEORY MATTER**

Composition and Music Theory are a part of the California Arts Education standards, but are frequently not taught. Amazing music nonprofits in Los Angeles are graduating students to college who find themselves behind in both subjects. The Inception Orchestra's Young Composers Mentoring Program fills this gap.





In 2020, Inception composers participated in thirty Saturday group mentoring sessions led by top industry professionals, in addition to weekly private lessons. Improvisation, creativity, and storytelling, along with music theory, were taught for the first three months.



From July-December, composers were introduced to every instrument of the orchestra, learning how to compose for each one.In 2021, the focus shifts to arranging, orchestration, and world music.

Since July, an all-volunteer team of staff mentors, led by Akira Nakano and Karen Elaine, and two Board members join each Saturday session to lend their expertise to our young composers.

Additionally, the team delivers a weekly private lesson to each composer.



"Inception's delivery grew **333%** between 2019 and 2020 with our delivery expanding nationwide, thanks to the virtual platform.

We will continue to grow with new partners, scaling our delivery by at least another 300% between 2020 and 2021. With our new partners, we are beginning to expand our footprint with additional classes and cohorts.


# FY20 FINANCIALS




